

Waterdale Code of Conduct (Production Team)

The purposes of the Association are –

1. To provide opportunities to youth to develop their skills and further their involvement in all aspects of theatre performance and production;
2. To produce and perform amateur theatrical and educational theatrical productions for the community;
3. To provide a supportive, productive and educational environment for young people to be a part of;
4. To provide a means of positive self-expression; and
5. To be role models for our community.

AS A PRODUCTION TEAM MEMBER I WILL:

1. Uphold the values of Waterdale.
2. Be professional, respectful and courteous in all dealings.
3. Refrain from using derogatory, offensive or abusive language.
4. Act fairly and impartially during auditions and casting.
5. Acknowledge that my position as a member of the production team inherently results in a power imbalance between myself and members of the cast.
6. Notify the Committee of any perceived or actual conflicts of interest.
7. Be professional and engage cooperatively with other members of the production team, the Committee, cast, crew and other members of the Waterdale community.
8. Take reasonable steps to care for my own health and safety.
9. Notify the Committee as soon as possible of any issues or incidents (including, but not limited to, physical injuries, health and safety risks, bullying, harassment, or victimisation).
10. Take reasonable steps to ensure that all items and venues (including, but not limited to, props, sets, scores, equipment and rehearsal and performance spaces) are treated respectfully.
11. Prepare for, attend, be on time for and contribute to meetings, rehearsals and other events.

I understand that my failure to comply with this Code may result in my expulsion from the production and/or termination as a member of Waterdale Theatre, subject to the terms of the Constitution.
